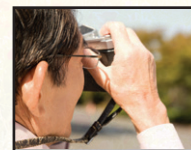

GENERAL INFORMATION

CLASS LOCATIONS: In-Person classes are held at Rockville High School (RHS). Check the course schedule for details on class dates, times, and locations.

- Registration Fees:** Fees are payable at the time of registration. Accepted forms of payment include check, cash, money order, MasterCard, or Visa. Some classes may have additional costs for books, materials, or lab fees (refer to individual course descriptions). Note: A \$30 fee will be charged for checks returned due to insufficient funds.
- Discounts:** A 25% discount on one class per semester is available for seniors (age 62+) and military personnel (active, reserves, or retired). Discounted classes will indicate eligibility in the course description.
- Lab Fees:** For specified classes, lab fees are payable directly to the instructor in cash or money order on the first night of class (e.g., Florals, Jewelry, Photography, and Pottery). Personal checks are not accepted. Lab fees for other courses will be included in your total registration amount.
- Class Cancellations:** In case of inclement weather or other emergencies, cancellation notices will be posted on local TV stations, their websites, and the Continuing Education office voicemail. Call 860-870-6060, option 3, for updates. If day school is canceled or closes early, evening classes, including online ones, will also be canceled. Efforts will be made to reschedule classes, but no refunds will be issued if rescheduling is not possible within the semester.
- Teacher Absences:** If an instructor is absent, students will be notified, and the missed class will be rescheduled for an additional week at the end of the semester.

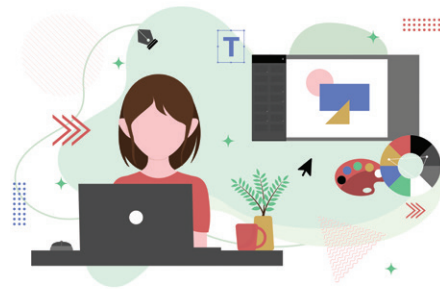

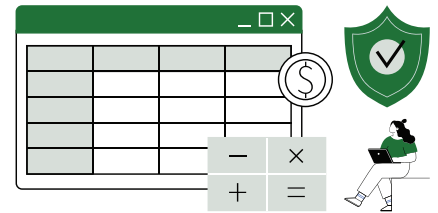

PRE-GED CLASSES (ABE)

This pre-GED course is designed for the student who needs to develop additional skills before enrolling in GED® test preparatory classes. Students work individually with the classroom teacher on math and basic literacy skills. Instructional levels range from beginning literacy to pre-GED readiness. For additional information, call 860-870-6060.

GED® TEST PREPARATION CLASSES

This course prepares students to pass the State of Connecticut administered GED® Test. The computer-based GED® Test is administered at approved GED Testing Centers throughout the State. The GED® test covers four content areas – literacy, mathematics, science and social studies. Students 17 and older can enroll in the GED® test preparatory classes. Individuals ages 17 or 18 must submit documentation that they have been withdrawn from school for at least six months prior to registering for the test. An applicant 21 years of age or older and a non-veteran must pay a fee of \$13 to register to take the GED® test. There is no registration fee for veterans or individuals under the age of 21. Accommodations on the GED® test may be available for individuals with a documented disability. We offer GED® test preparation classes in Colchester, East Windsor, Glastonbury, Griswold, Mansfield, Vernon, and Wethersfield. Both day and evening classes are available in Vernon. NEW! REIMAGINE YOUR IMAGES: The Art of Photo Editing using ACR

Photoshop, made by Adobe, is probably the most well-known and, arguably, the best digital imaging program on the market today. However, accompanying Photoshop is another very powerful program called Adobe Camera Raw (ACR). It originally was designed for processing RAW images (most SLR cameras save an image either in the JPG or RAW format - a RAW image is a much more robust entity than a JPG image, and it's the format to use for serious digital editing). There are three reasons Adobe Camera Raw may be preferable to Photoshop for digital editing:

- As wonderful as Photoshop is, its complexity makes mastering it a long-term challenge. Adobe Camera Raw, though still demanding, is considerably easier to learn and use.
- ACR is a muscular program with an extensive variety of editing tools. It has more than enough resources to meet the requirements of many amateur and professional photographers.
- ACR is designed to edit not only RAW images, but also JPG, TIF, and other image formats.

What most people don't realize is that editing is almost mandatory for making a

picture look the same as what the naked eye originally saw. Therefore, all images can benefit from at least some editing. At the very least, dark areas should be lightened and light areas darkened, colors should be improved, sharpness and contrast should be added, and distracting elements removed.

Further, editing can be used to transform photographs into something entirely different and unique. That's usually my goal. I create images in ACR that I think are a vast improvement over what my camera captures (you can view some of my edited pictures at www.peterglass.com/portfolio).

A very complete handout will be distributed in class. It contains lots of information and will greatly simplify the process of understanding what's being taught. In addition, the handout will allow you to spend less time taking notes and more time listening and participating in class. You'll also find it quite useful for review after you get home.

The current version of Photoshop (which includes ACR) is available through Adobe on a subscription basis only. The cost is about \$15 - \$20 per month, which is very reasonable since Adobe upgrades and fixes issues without you needing to do so. (Please note that owning Photoshop is not a requirement for taking this seminar.) And even if you'd prefer using another editing program instead of ACR, you'll find that what you've learned in this class will most likely apply to that program as well. By the way, ACR is the program I use for almost 90% of my digital editing.

Towns include Ashford, Bolton, Colchester, Coventry, East Windsor, Ellington, Glastonbury, Griswold, Mansfield, South Windsor, Tolland, Vernon, Wethersfield and Willington.



PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

ELIGIBILITY: The State of Connecticut's minimum age for students to drop out of high school and attend adult education is 17 years old.

WHAT DO I NEED TO START:

- (1) **WITHDRAWAL:** Age 17 & 18 ONLY: A letter of withdrawal from your former high school. No out-of-state high school withdrawals will be accepted. NOTE: Out-of-state students must go to their CT town of residence high school to execute a withdrawal from a CT school.
- (2) **IDENTIFICATION:** State or Government issued I.D. (CT driver's license, CT State I.D., Passport, Military I.D.). NOTE: Out-of-state students must provide proof of residency (i.e. lease, utility bill, recent mail to you at CT address).
- (3) **CDP-CREDIT DIPLOMA STUDENTS ONLY:** An "OFFICIAL" transcript is REQUIRED to register for CDP classes.

FOR ADULT STUDENTS TAKING ENRICHMENT CLASSES AT ROCKVILLE HIGH SCHOOL

You must enter Rockville High School through either the main doors facing Loveland Hill Road or the back doors on the A.S.T.E. (north) side of the building. You may park in the lot in front of the building or in the lot on the north side of the building. Please note that parking in the large lot on the south side of the building will result in a very long walk to either the front main entrance or the rear entrance. These are the only two entrances you may use.

Traveling East: Leave Interstate 84 at exits 64-65 and bear left as the ramp divides. When the ramp divides again, bear right to the stoplight, where you will be on Route 83 North. Continue to the 10th stoplight on Route 83 and turn right onto Loveland Hill Road. Rockville High School is at the top of the hill on the right. Follow Loveland Hill Road to the first stop sign and take a right into the parking lot on the north side of the building.
